INDIVIDUAL TEAM MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

By signing this document and participating in any and all events conducted by the World Junior BBQ League, you agree to the following:

1. Team Member must be in good standing with the World Junior BBQ League.
2. Must be in grades 9 through 12 or the equivalent homeschool standing, or between the ages of 14 and 18.
3. Must conduct themselves in a friendly, courteous, and professional manner. Must not speak negatively of other teams, mentors, judges, or any other person on site.
4. Must not use foul, abusive, or unacceptable language or any other language causing a disturbance.
5. There is a zero tolerance policy for theft, dishonesty, cheating, or any act leading to immoral conduct.
6. There is a zero tolerance alcohol policy for anyone under the age of 21.
7. No use of tobacco or vape products, including cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco, and electronic cigarettes is permitted within the event area. This includes any sort of marijuana products, regardless of whether or not the substance is legal in that state.
8. No music will be permitted to be played by a competitor during the times marked as “quiet hours” as designated by the individual event.
9. The use of headphones or individual usage of sound device during the competition times is restricted. This is due to any potential safety hazards involved with distractions.
10. It is a violation to possess or carry any weapon within the contest area including firearms, explosives, BB guns, stun guns, air rifles or pistols, sling shots, or any sharp instrument. Knives meant solely for the purpose of the competition are permitted.
11. Use of any illegal drugs or controlled substances (unless prescribed by a doctor, with proof of prescription), is strictly prohibited in the event area. Any marijuana or cannabis substance, as mentioned above (#7) is also strictly prohibited. Team Members must not sell, buy, transfer, or distribute drugs or drug paraphernalia while on the event premises.
12. Actions of one member of a team could result in actions taken against the entire team.
13. Team Member not abiding by these rules as well as Team Rules will result in the disqualification from the event or the expulsion from Membership with the World Junior BBQ League. The violation of any local, state, or federal laws will result in contacting the authorities.
